### Speaker Profiles

**Dr. Elizabeth Wade, ND**, is a Board-Certified Naturopathic Doctor who specializes in women's health, with a particular emphasis on preconception and infertility. She earned her Doctorate in Naturopathic Medicine from the National University of Natural Medicine (NUNM). Before NUNM, she received her B.A. from University of Iowa, with an emphasis in International Relations and Sociology. Dr. Wade strives to ensure that all women have access to the information, education, and solutions they need to treat their health issues in the most effective, least invasive way possible.

**Elizabeth Stoos, M.Ed.**, is the Melanoma Program Manager and Instructional Designer at Oregon Health Sciences University's Department of Dermatology. She received her B.A. at New St. Andrew's College in Moscow, ID and graduated *cum laude*. She received her Master's of Education at Northeastern University in Boston, MA. Dr. Stoos will present the newly developed educational module that is the next step in campaigning for early melanoma detection to lower the death rate from skin cancer. Her lecture is a follow-up to Dr. Sancy Leachman's talk from last year.

**Stacy Morgan, LE, CPE**, graduated from Accurate Academy of Electrology in 2011, and became a CPE in 2013. She has served as both Secretary and Vice-President for the Electrology Association of Illinois (EAI), while also becoming Editor of *Electrology Illinois*, the news publication of EAI. Stacy is co-Founder of Illinois Dedicated Electrology Academy, where she is also a Certified Instructor. Her lecture topics feature important information that is essential to all Electrologists: Time Management, Consultations, and Positioning.

**Kate Kauffman, LPC**, has provided transgender-specific therapy, supervision, and training in Oregon for five years. Her education includes immersive experiences with youth and families at TransActive Gender Center. She is currently in private practice, serving all ages, at Brave Space, LLC, which is committed to helping trans-affirming providers become expert providers while taking their service to the next level. Kate's presentation will include basic knowledge and etiquette for affirming and supportive care as electrologists.

**Dr. Brian Wilkinson, PT, DPT, CHT, CLT, CCI**, became a Doctor in Physical Therapy at the University of Southern California in Los Angeles. Along with his many licenses and certifications, Dr. Wilkinson is Assistant Professor and Director of Clinical Education at Pacific University's School of Physical Therapy and Athletic Training. He also has a Physical Therapy practice at Premise Health. His lecture will focus on corrective exercises designed to help avoid body stress and other physical disorders.
